

Huddersfield Petanque Club Marsh Gates, Greenhead Park



The terrain is at the northernmost point of the park near a set of iron gates near a pub called the Junction. Very good range of real ales.

There is no dedicated parking so you have to park on street and it sometimes becomes crowded. Leave 5 extra minutes for parking.

From M62 Junction 24

Towards town centre for 2 miles. Turn right at traffic lights on to Edgerton Grove Road and at roundabout go straight ahead to see Park entrance. The gates are usually closed apart from pedestrians.

From M62 Junction 23

Towards town centre for 2 miles. New Hey Road turns into Westbourne Road. At second roundabout just after Shell garage turn right to see Park entrance.

From Town Centre

Use the ring road and turn up Trinity Street between springwood parking area & Huddersfield College. Keep going to the roundabout & turn left to Park entrance.

By Train

Trains from Manchester and Leeds. Turn right outside Huddersfield station up St Georges Street onto Westgate and walk up to where Trinity Street meets ring road. Cross over and keep going up Trinity Street. It's about a 15 minute walk.

By Bus

Many buses go from many places to different gates of the Park. See more at www.wymetro.com It's about 15 minutes walk from the town centre bus station.

Parking

It's all on street and some is time limited but it is free. Here are some roads to try.

Park Drive. Disabled bays at the northern end very near the terrain. 3 hours limit most of the road. Start looking for a place here. It's one way so enter from Trinity street near the south eastern corner of the park or Vernon street a little higher up.

If it's full turn left and go down **Gledholt Road** and start looking for a place on the left. If you haven't seen one by the time you get to **Quarry Road** (first on right) then turn right and shortly after right again onto **Grasmere Road** where there should be places.

If not bear right onto **Clifton Road** and I've always found a place here. **Grasscroft Road** is also worth a look.

Park Drive South often has places but it's a long walk through the park to the terrain.

There's no public car park within a mile.

The club has a storage room but it's shared with other organisations and not quite a clubhouse. There are good quality public toilets next to the park café within 80 metres. The pub also has toilets.

The club has plenty of plastic garden chairs and is working on installing some solid park benches.
