

# Kirklees Autumn League

1. A league shall be formed from petanque clubs in Kirklees. Clubs in the league will have a terrain that can accommodate 2 matches side by side. The league will take place from September to November.

2. Teams shall play each other home and away. There will be 2 triple matches (a men's game and a women's game) followed by 3 mixed doubles matches in each fixture.

Home A v Away A, Home B v Away B, Home C v Away C, Home D v Away D, Home E v Away E.

3. Teams shall consist of a minimum of 6 players and will be members of the club they represent. There will be 3 male and 3 female players. A player can only play for one club in any season. Clubs can move members in and out of the team as required without notice. Team Captain can substitute players and organise teams at any time until a game starts. A club who cannot find enough players to play a game will forfeit the game. All such games will be 7-13 defeats. Where Clubs have more than one team players cannot move between teams once they have played a league match.

4. The league will be won by the team winning most games. A game is where one side reaches 13 points. Points difference will resolve any ties. No use will be made of fixtures or matches in determining places.

5. Matches will be played once a week on a day, time and date convenient to both teams. If the home club has a regular day and time this should be the default day/time for the match if the teams cannot agree a suitable date/time.

6. Results will be reported to the League organiser by email by both teams within 24 hours of the fixture. Paper records of the fixture should be kept by both teams countersigned by the opponents. A results list and a league table will be published on the internet by the League organiser every week once results are in.

7. Entry fee to the league will be £5 per team. This will be used to buy a shield as a perpetual trophy. Any surplus will be retained by the organiser and reported to the league members at the end of the season.
