### **1. Minutes of meeting June 6th & matters arising :**

### **2. New Clubhouse**

We next need to Register our title to the land

Lease requires we insure new building. Paul to get quotes. Ian to be asked for help KMC confirmed they will level the ground in preparation for the new building in lieu of their promised £2K contribution. The area needs to be defined for KMC.

We need to raise circa £10K - £5K shed £5K other and co. Paul/Roy to investigate sources of funds including Crowd Funding and Just Giving on Facebook.

We will build the cabin ourselves. Needs to be painted green. Building project to be recorded using time-lapse photography

Approx. 2 weeks lead time from ordering shed to delivery when everything must be in place - ground works, club volunteers etc.
