### COVID - 19 UPDATE: Return to restricted play

#### Safe play guidelines for Doubles games

- Wash your hands with soap and water for at least 20 seconds before leaving home and on return.
- Each player should touch their own boules and equipment only.
- Each player must have their own jack. If a jack is invalidly thrown the opposing team must either kick the jack or place a jack of their own, not pick up the jack that is invalid.
- Plastic circles must not be used. Mark a circle with your foot or a marker which should be used by one person only.
- Maintain social distancing of 2m between players at all times. If possible stand side on, even at 2m distance. Avoid standing face to face.
- Clean your equipment both before and after use.
- Club scoreboards not to be used. Each side to keep scores using pocket scorers or something similar.
- No matches to take place on adjacent lanes. We will use the 7 alternate lanes between lanes 2 and 14 inclusive.
- Players may wish to consider wearing a face covering and/or gloves.
- Spectators should only attend if they can watch safely and respect 2m social distancing.
- The club house will not be open. Park toilets will not be open.
- After playing do not congregate in groups of more than 6 and maintain 2m social distancing.

After your game is finished please cover over all the circles made on the terrain. Leave the terrain as you would expect to find it.
